



CHANGING YOUR ATTORNEY MID-STREAM

It is not unusual for a client to sometimes change attorneys. As a consumer of legal services, you have a right to retain any attorney that you want. You also have a right to terminate your client relationship with an attorney.

If you are presently represented and want to change attorneys, then we will assist you in the following manner: We will meet with you to obtain an overview of your legal matter. We will want to know your concerns and how you think your concerns can be addressed. We will need information regarding the status of your case; for example, is there a hearing or a trial on the court's calendar?

You may interview us and ask any questions that you have about how we do business or how we may handle your file. You then make a determination if you wish to change counsel and have us take over your case.

If you decide to retain this firm, then we will contact your former attorney and obtain all of your documentation. You need not engage in the sometimes uncomfortable task of informing your attorney that you are terminating services and retaining other counsel. We will inform your attorney via letter and by a Notice of Substitution of Counsel.

We will also let the court know that we are now representing you by filing the Notice of Substitution of Counsel with the court and by a letter to the court.
